A: Reverse engines at highest speed possible

A: Right

A: 'Stop' 'Full Astern' 'Hard-a-starboard'

A: '6 watertight compartments are breached. She will stay afloat for 2 hours at most.'

Q: How many collapsible lifeboats were onboard Titanic?

A: 4

A: The Carpathia took survivors to New York.

A: 62 seconds
